	You will be offered a spot as a Junior Board Member of the PKUIL where you will go behind the scenes and learn the “ins and outs” of running a 501(c)3 organization.
	Although not required as part of the internship, we welcome you to join our monthly board meetings and help plan our events
August	Internship ends with a trip to Springfield, IL to follow up with the congressman and wrap up all of your hard work at the end of Summer
